

## QUAN YIN'S GRID FOR PURITY AND INNOCENCE - April, 2005

### Materials:

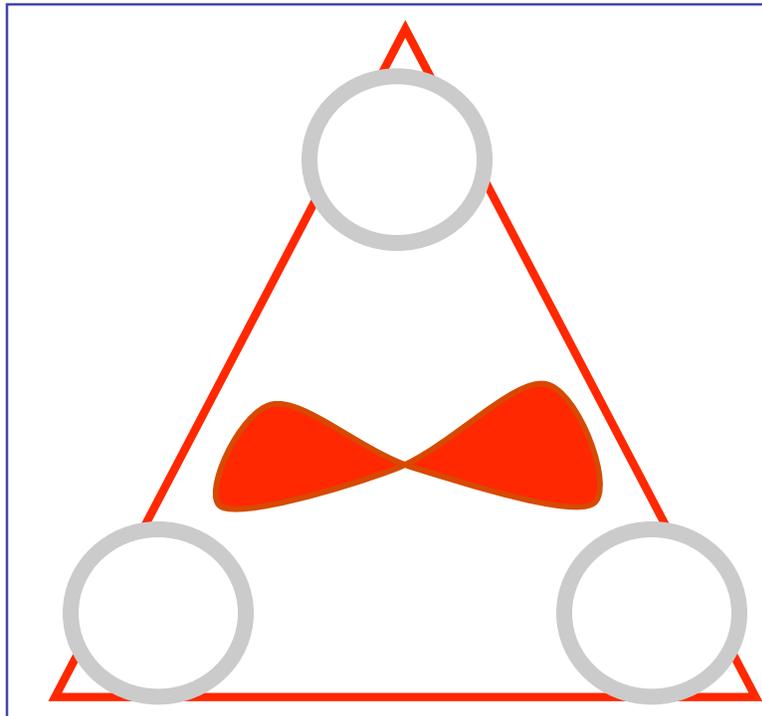
3 white pillar candles 3x9 inches  
large piece of paper 12x12 inches  
red felt pen  
ruler  
2-4 tablespoons cinnamon

Make a grid and light three white candles, 3" x 9" pillars, for as long as they will last.

If you were to set them on a piece of paper, cut 12 inches across, you will have a square in which you will draw an equilateral triangle of 9 inches. Then place the three candles in the triangle. The triangle should be drawn in red ink or red felt pen and be about 1/2 inch thick so that even when you place the candles on top of it, you can see the triangle.

As you place the three white pillar candles each on one point of the red triangle, you will then make the sign of infinity in the center of the triangle, drawing it also in the color red, large enough that it will fit right in the center of the triangle. The total size can be about 3 1/2 inches across so that each of the loops will be just over 1 1/2 inches. It is perfectly fine if it is a little bigger or smaller but it must be a decent size.

Then fill the entire sign of infinity with the color red and upon completing this, you want to fill it with two mounds of cinnamon – one loop of the sign of infinity is offered to the Mother Aspect energy and the other loop to the Daughter Aspect Energy.



## QUAN YIN'S GRID FOR COMPASSION – MAY 1, 2005

Materials:  
3 purple pink or dusty pink pillar candles 3x9 inches  
large piece of paper 12x12 inches  
pink felt pen  
ruler  
rose water  
small clear container

Set up the same sized paper and 9 inch equilateral triangle, only this time you will draw the triangle with pink-colored pen and the sign of infinity in the center also with pink colored pen. Set the three compassion candles in the same way on the corners of the triangle in the grid.

In this grid, instead of the cinnamon, you will place on the center of the sign of infinity a small, clear container filled with rose water bought from any store.
